A great option to renew membership dues is paying over the phone to National at <u>317-569-4570</u> or online at <u>www.alaforveterans.org</u>. A membership number is required.

The Membership Awards will be the same this year, (10X10 and Recruit/Rejoin 5) with a few date changes. The Unit Award for 100% is to reach goal by November 10, 2020. The unit will be placed into a random drawing from which 100 units will be selected to receive \$100 from National.

Membership Goals for the units will be 1 member over the membership as of August 3, 2020.

Also, National Headquarters is discontinuing the "Honor Female Veteran" program. The \$12 portion of membership dues will no longer be waived by Headquarters. This is done so as to not exclude any Veteran, since we now accept male spouses in the Auxiliary.

The 1st renewal notices will be sent out from National by September 15, 2020 and the 2nd notices by early 2021.



ATTENTION Changes **American Legion Auxiliary Honor Our Female Veterans**

National will be discontinuing the HONOR **FEMALE VETERANS** program starting with the 2021 Membership year, the national organization will no longer waive the \$12.00 national portion of dues to female veterans that are new members. The Department will follow suit and will not waiver the \$11.00.

Now that our organization has opened our eligibility to allow male spouses, many of which are veterans themselves, we feel that it is best to retire this program as to not exclude any veteran. In addition, the renewal rate of female veterans who joined through this program has diminished beyond our normal rate of renewals as well as fewer female veterans are joined through this program each year.

ALA MIS PROGRAM ACCESS for **Units/District Membership**

Monies are DUE into Dept when Access is Requested.

The fee is \$10 per year per person (2 per Unit). This is the fee National charges. Forms are on the website or call the Department for copies. Due to the enforced rules all forms must be completed and signed by 5 current Unit Officer. At no time is an authorized person using ALA MIS is to share their password with anyone. If a person needs to be changed please send in a new form right away. Please let us know ASAP.

If Unit wants to continue having access to the ALA MIS the department must receive new forms and \$10 for each person per calendar year.

New: District Presidents can now have access to all the Units in their districts. This will be a read only and cannot make any changes. The fee is \$10 and will be good until December.
