ALA MIS PROGRAM ACCESS for Units/District Membership

<u>Monies are DUE into Dept when Access is</u> <u>Requested.</u>

The fee is \$10 per year per person (2 per Unit). This is the fee National charges. Forms are on the website or call the Department for copies. Due to the enforced rules all forms must be completed and signed by 5 current Unit Officer. At no time is an authorized person using ALA MIS is to share their password with anyone. If a person needs to be changed please send in a new form right away. Please let us know ASAP. If Unit wants to continue having access to the ALA MIS the department must receive new forms and \$10 for each person per calendar year.

New: District Presidents can now have access to all the Units in their districts. This will be a read only and cannot make any changes. The fee is \$10 and will be good until December.

American Legion Auxiliary Honor Our Female Veterans

For Female Veterans who join as new members for the 2020 Membership Year, the national portion of dues (\$12) will be waived for their first year of membership.

The American Legion Auxiliary Department of Georgia voted at our Fall Conference in 2015, for Female Veterans who join as new members for the 2020 Membership Year, the Department's portion will also be waived for their first year of membership.

Some of the Units are waiving their membership portion as well.

Ladies this is one way we can Honor Our Female Veterans and build our membership. Lets' make them feel welcome!

WHERE: Statesboro, Georgia at Georgia Southern University

WHEN: June 7– 12, 2020

Fee is \$300.00 per girl

District Counselor Fee of \$300.00 and counselor selection is due ASAP

QUALIFICATIONS: Interest in government, leadership, citizenship, honesty, scholarship, character, and completion of their **junior** year in high school.

ORIENTATION: Orientation should be a part of your Girls State plan so that the girls and their parents understand in advance what to expect upon arrival. Please call on a staff member in your area to help with your orientation if help is needed. Former Girls Citizens can also be helpful when getting students prepared for the session.

PUBILICITY: Unit chairmen, be sure to contact local media for coverage as soon as your delegates have been selected. Many newspapers are willing to publish pictures and short articles about the program. Invite delegates to a unit meeting after the session to report to the unit.

As many of you already know, Georgia Girls State 2020 will use an Online Application. The 2020 online application is on the website. A few changes have been made. http://www.georgiagirlsstate.org

In the Online Application, there is a 'Need Help?' drop down menu. If you have General Girls State questions, you may click on 'General Questions' and complete the form. I will receive this information and respond accordingly. If you have technical questions or are experiencing any issues with the application itself, click on 'Technical Questions,' complete the form, and our Technical Support Team will contact you directly.

You may contact Cynthia Orms directly (cmorms65@gmail.com) or her cell 478-232-4831) to assist you with the applications again this year.

Please note that the Application is divided into multiple sections which are completed by the different parties involved (i.e., Auxiliary, Student, School and Parent/Guardian). Each section requires a different set of credentials to complete it. Please notify your high schools of these changes.

FEE: Checks must be made out to Girls State and mailed to the Department Headquarters. **Send the fee of \$300.00 per girl to** the American Legion Auxiliary Department Headquarters, 3035 Mt. Zion Road, Stockbridge, GA 30281 **before April 20, 2020** to assure space for your girls.

If you find out that a girl is not coming after having sent in her application, please let us know. We make phone calls to all no shows on Sunday, June 7, 2020, and it will help us if we can limit the number of calls necessary. Let us know even up the last day.

After I received the application, I will send the forms packets to the girls. If you plan to print the forms packet for your girls, please MAKE sure the documents are for the current year. The system will email forms to all girls, but you can provide copies of the current forms to the girls.
