On April 23rd – 26th National held our first Virtual DLNC (Department Leadership National Conference). All sorts of information were delivered and I'm sure you will not want to miss our 2021-2022 Leadership Training which will be hosted by Patricia Morgan, who has submitted nomination for 1st Vice President for the 2021-22 year.

DEC continues to meet via Zoom. We held our budget meeting at Dept. Headquarters May 1st and it was tedious but what we came to accomplished was accomplished. Budget will be presented to the body at June Post Convention.

Feature Unit: Unit 233, Loganville

The Naming of American Legion Post/Unit 233, Loganville, Georgia

Barrett-Davis-Watson, American Legion Auxiliary, Unit 233. Loganville, GA

On November 21, 1948, a committee from the Loganville American Legion Post met and chose a name. The actual words of the committee are:

"We your committee, after due care not to let the matter get into political influences and with respect to all the good people of this community, decided to name it as the losses came and honoring all the boys of the town, agreed to call the post BARRETT-DAVIS-WATSON POST for the ones who did not come back."

Guy Jennings Barrett, Jr. was born in Jersey, Georgia and later made his home in Loganville, Georgia. He enlisted in the Naval Air Corps on August 20, 1942 and trained at Athens Preflight School and later at Olathe. Kansas. Guy received his commission at Corpus Christi, Texas and joined Squadron VF-26 in Alameda, California. Early in the morning of October 24, 1944, he was the fourth to take off to fly over Japan on target combat air patrol. Guy was in the air a short time when witnesses saw him crash into the water, about 125 miles from Leyte Island. A painstaking search was conducted but he could not be found. Raymond Martin Davis, Jr. was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Raymond Davis, Sr. and graduated from Loganville High School. He enlisted in the United States Army on November 18. 1943. Raymond completed basic training at Camp Shelby, Mississippi and embarked for Europe from Camp George B. Meade,

Maryland. He landed in southern Italy on July 1, 1944, where he remained for thirty days before going into battle. Raymond was part of the invasion of Southern France with the 7th Infantry Division. He was killed in combat on February 3, 1945 in Espinal, France. William Leamon Watson was born in Lawrenceville, Georgia and graduated from high school in Commerce, Georgia. His family moved to Loganville when he enlisted in the United States Army on September 16, 1940. Leamon trained at Fort Benning, Georgia and joined the 36th Armored Infantry Regiment. As part of the Third Armored Division, he fought in five western European campaigns. Leamon was one of two volunteers for an extremely dangerous mission, who, with General Maurice Rose, died in combat on March 31, 1945, near Paderborn, Germany. The American Legion Auxiliary, Unit 233 charter was signed on January 12, 1947 by National President Dorothy Pearl and Department President Mrs. Fuller Pedrick and has been an active and ongoing Unit since its conception. The Unit has had a total of 27 Unit Presidents since the charter was signed. Evelyn Boss served in that capacity for 16 years. After that period, the Unit decided changed their bylaws to limit time served to 3 years. The Unit has won the National Presidents Outstanding Unit Excellence Award twice for all the work they do carrying out the programs for the Auxiliary. Since the 2011 through 2020 the Unit has shipped over 6,377 CARE boxes to our soldiers in Korea, Iraq and Afghanistan and spent \$80,490.91 in postage. Even though we are providing this valuable service to our active military, we have not forgotten our other programs such as VA&R and our Military War Veterans Home, our community with assisting local battered women's shelter, education with supplies and scholarships and all the other programs worked by the Auxiliary. We believe in serving our veterans, the community and our children and youth.






