ALA DEPARTMENT OF GEORGIA CONSTITUTION: ARTICLE VI - DEPARTMENT CONVENTION

Section 1. The legislative body of the American Legion Auxiliary, Department of Georgia, shall be the Department Convention to be held annually at the same time and place as the Department Convention of the American Legion, Department of Georgia.

Section 2. Representation in the Department Convention shall be by Unit.

Section 3. Delegates-at-large to the Department Convention shall be the elective officers, members of the Department Executive Committee, the Chairpersons of Standing Committees, Hospital Representatives, and all Past Department Presidents in good standing in their Units and with vote to be exercised with their respective Units.

Section 4. The delegates and alternates to the Department Convention shall be elected at Unit meetings held not less than two (2) weeks prior to the Department Convention. Alternates shall have priority in the order of their election.

Section 5. Each Unit shall be entitled to two (2) delegates and one (1) additional delegate for each twenty-five (25) members or major fraction thereof whose current dues have been received by the Department Treasury thirty (30) days prior to the Department Convention and to one alternate for each delegate. Units shall be entitled to one (1) vote each for Past Department of Georgia Presidents, Current Department Officers and Department Chairpersons, and Hospital Representatives.

Section 6. The Unit delegation shall include the Unit President who shall be Chairperson of the delegation.

Section 7. Each delegate shall be entitled to one (1) vote. The vote of any absent delegate who is not represented by an alternate shall be cast by the majority vote of the delegates present from the Unit.
