**Rules for UNIT MEMBER OF THE YEAR**

1. Only senior members in good standing are eligible.
2. The nominee must be current on membership dues.
3. The member cannot have obtained an elected or appointed leadership role higher than Unit President.
4. Selection is based on accomplishments, activities, etc. for the current administrative year.
5. Years of membership is not a part of the criteria; the nominee may be a new member.
6. Each Unit may submit only one entry.
7. The Unit must submit a narrative of 1,000 words or less describing the nominee's accomplishments and activities together with the nominee's name and address. The Unit President and Secretary must sign the entry form unless the nominee is one of them, in which case a Past Unit President must sign the entry form.
8. All entries must be post-marked by **May 1**

**Information:** Departments will submit one entry to the National Leadership program including the unit’s narrative on or before June 1st and must be entered by the Leadership or PPP chairman electronically using the national format. Recognition of the winners occurs at the American Legion Auxiliary’s national convention. The application deadline is June 1 of each calendar year.
